Lots containing five or more stamps are not returnable on account of minor defects, and no lots are returnable by bidders who have had the privilege of examining lots before sale.
4. All stamps are guaranteed genuine. Should any lot prove otherwise, purchase price will be refunded. This does not apply to lots described and sold "As Is."
5. The right is reserved to withdraw any lot offered.
