1. All bids are per lot and not per piece.
2. All lots are sold for CASH and must be taken up not later than three (3) days after the sale. Payment may be made in unused U. S. Postage Stamps in denominations from the 1c to 5c if 5% extra is added to cover cost of brokerage. All stamps must have full original gum and not be mutilated.
3. The bidding will be made in the following units — 5c below \$1.00; 10c from \$1.00 to \$10.00 and 25c above \$10.00.
4. Successful mail bidders, unless they are well known to us or send references, will be notified of the amount of the lots secured for them, and are expected to send payment in full, including registration or insurance, before lots are forwarded.
5. No lots can be returned after three (3) days for any reason. Claims will positively not be entertained after this time. Lot containing 5 or more stamps cannot be returned at any time. Floor bidders cannot return any lots purchased. Lots are on display for one full week before the sale.
6. We reserve the right to withdraw any lot prior to sale.
