DESCRIPTIONS

Superb—the finest condition for noteworthy, outstanding copies.

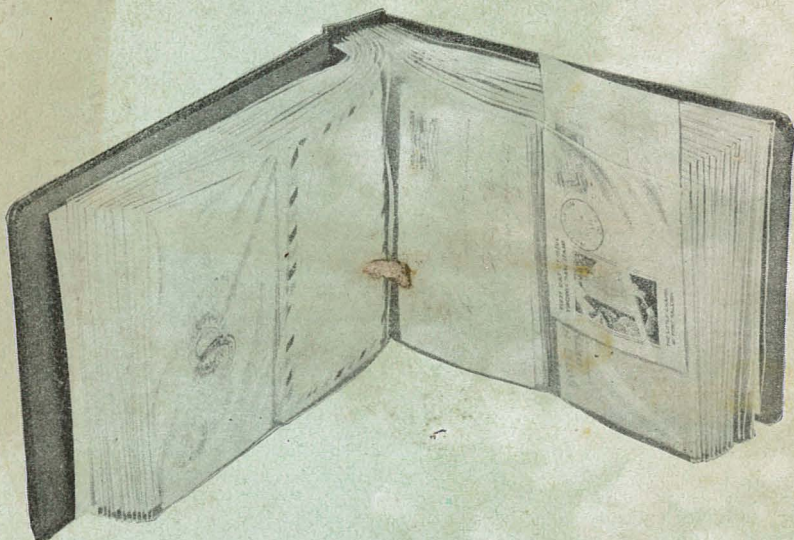
