CONDITIONS OF SALE

1. The terms of sale are strictly cash to the highest bidder. All buyers are expected to pay for lots within three days of receipt, unless special arrangements have been made prior to the sale.
2. All bids are per lot as numbered in the catalogue and not per piece, unless otherwise announced by the auctioneer at the time of sale.
3. Any lot the description of which is incorrect is returnable only within three days of receipt. All disputed lots must be returned intact as received. Lots containing five or more stamps are not returnable at any time. No lots may be returned by purchasers who have had the opportunity to examine them before the sale.
4. Successful mail bidders, unless they are known to us or supply acceptable references, will be notified of the amount of the lots secured for them, and are expected to send payment in full before the lots are forwarded.
5. If the purchase price has not been paid within the time limit, or lots taken up within seven days from date of sale, they may be resold and any losses arising from such sale charged to the defaulter.
6. All stamps are sold as genuine, except where sold "As Is". Claims for any lot proving otherwise, must be made within two weeks from date of sale.
7. The right is reserved to group two or more lots, also withdraw any lot or lots from the sale, or to act on behalf of the seller.
8. Until paid for in full all lots remain the property of Robert A. Siegel Auctions.
9. No commission is charged for buying at our sales, but all forwarding charges will be added to the purchase price.
10. In addition to the purchase price, the buyer will be required to pay the one (1) percent New York City sales tax, unless he is exempt from the payment thereof.

Superb—the finest condition for noteworthy, outstanding copies.

Very Fine (VF)—means that there is a slight deviation from the above.

Fine (F)—means that the perforations do not touch the design on issues after 1890, but in some cases may just touch in earlier issues; if used, fairly lightly cancelled.

Very Good (VG)—means that the appearance is generally fine but that the perforations cut the design slightly.

Good (G)—means average off-centering; or fairly attractive with slight defects. Original gum is not to be expected on 19th Century stamps up to 1888 unless so stated.

Foreword

It is our pleasure and privilege to offer an outstanding collection of United States stamps, pointedly the issues of 1851 through 1861.

This is a collection that should interest *every* collector of United States stamps.

Is that a far-reaching statement? Is it akin to that one told about the little girl (or boy) whose mother told her thousands of other little girls would like her spinach?

The answer—you and I know—is "*Name One*".

In the matter of this collection, formed by a California collector who prefers anonymity, the answer as to the number of collectors likely to want some of the nice stamps in this collection, is — "*MANY*". This commentator leaves the exact numbers naming to you.

This Catalogue as here presented, proves the words, for there is an abundance of first-rate postage stamps of the 1851-1861 period, in all their variations, as issued and as used on and off covers.

Many of the stamps are offered for their varied cancellations, especially in the 1861 issue. These are part of a four-volume section of the eighteen volume collection on sale.

There is another point of interest in this collection. Each stamp, single, multiple piece and cover, is neatly mounted on cardboard, properly annotated and will be sold exactly as they were contained in this unusual collection. (Note Illustrations)

These lots can be placed on your album pages, without in any manner, detracting from your present annotations or extra-illustrations. If anything, these mounted stamps, from this excellent California collection, will enhance the appearance of your album.

Much could be said about this diversified collection, about its completeness and its features, but the thought occurs that words cannot supplant facts, so the suggestion is put forth: the facts are in the Catalogue.

Read the descriptions, note the representative illustrations, join the group who, having seen the collection, consider it to be "as fine a lot" as one could wish to own, covering the 1851-1861 period.
