6. All stamps are sold as genuine, except where sold "As Is." Claims for any lot proving otherwise, must be made within two weeks from date of sale.

Good (G)—means average off-centering; or fairly attractive with slight defects. Original gum is not to be expected on 19th Century stamps up to 1888 unless so stated. (OG) Mint—have never been hinged.
