# GEORGE CLARKE SLAWSON 1905 - 1969

There is always a measure of sadness when the collection of a well-known and much-loved philatelist is dispersed and it is particularly true in the case of the George Slawson Collection.

We have known George for many years as an outstanding student and as a good friend, but it is in the nature of Philately that the collections of the future are built upon those of the past and there should be some consolation in the knowledge that his many friends will all have equal opportunity to participate in the distribution of his holdings and thereby enrich their own collections.

George Slawson was a distinguished philatelist in every sense of the word. He was an Honorary Life Member of the United Postal Stationery Society and was Editor for U. S. Possessions Issues. He was a leading authority of U. S. Postal Cards and was largely responsible for the present listings of these issues in the Scott Catalogue. He was a Fellow of the Royal Philatelic Society of London, a member of the Collector's Club of New York, a member of the American Philatelic Society, of the Essay and Proof Society and of the United States Classics Society.

Most of all, however, he was noted for his research into the postal history of his adopted state, Vermont, and was Past President of the Vermont Philatelic Society, Editor of the "Vermont Philatelist" and co-author of the newly published "Postal History of Vermont", the most authoritative work in its field.

Perhaps the most fitting memorial to George is his research and writings of his favored fields which will endure as long as Philately exists.

#### VERMONT POSTMARKS ON COVER

In preparing the exceptional collection of Vermont covers for sale it has been our aim to preserve as much of the research data as reasonably possible.

It was George Slawson's endeavor to build a collection showing postmarks from every post office in Vermont. The degree of completeness which he accomplished is remarkable. But, he was not satisfied merely to have every postoffice represented but every different type and usage he could locate found a place in his collection.

We are offering these portions of his collection in precisely the same arrangement he followed. These larger groups are offered individually by counties, plus the covers of individual larger cities. They are on the original album pages with all of his research notes.

We have estimated the value of these lots on a basis of their intrinsic value as covers, stampless or stamped, not as Vermont postmarks. We hardly feel that we can estimate them on a basis of being Vermont covers; only the Vermont specialist can do that. Numerous covers are unique, or nearly so. Only the Vermont specialist can appreciate what such covers may be worth to him.

Our valuations are based on the covers up to 1908 or thereabouts. The collection also contains occasional later covers, including very recent ones to show the Zip Code postmarks. They are included in the collections, though not in the count or valuation.
