Good (G)—means average off-centering; or fairly attractive with slight defects. Original gum (OG)—is not to be expected on 19th Century stamps unless so stated.

Mint-with original gum and never hinged.

Plate Blocks—Minor perforation separation in selvedge only is not noted in description. Reduced selvedge noted on tops; on sides and bottoms only if plate number is touched
