No illustrated lots may be returned because of centering, margins or other factors shown in the illustrations.
- 4. Successful bidders, unless they are known to us or supply acceptable references are expected to make payment in full before the lots are delivered. Mail bidders will be notified of the amount of their purchases. All mail bidders who have established credit with us must make payment within three days after receipt.
