

FOREWORD

He is a friend to all collectors, and was privileged to know first-hand such wellknown Philatelists as Stanley P. Ashbrook, Emerson Krug, Edgar Jessup, Delores and Dr. Jay Hertz, Ben Newman, Dr. Clarence Hennan, Tony Russo, Richard Cabeen and many others.

Even though he is disposing of his 1847-1867 material, Paul still retains an active interest in Philately.





FINE: Perforations or margins do not touch design on issues after 1890 but in some cases may just touch in earlier issues. If used, fairly light cancellation.


VERY GOOD: Generally nice appearance but margins or perforations may cut in slightly.
