3. All bids are per lot as numbered in the catalogue unless otherwise announced by the auctioneer at the time of sale. The right is reserved to group two or more lots; to withdraw any lot or lots from the sale, or to act on behalf of the seller. The Galleries will bid on behalf of clients, but will not be responsible for any errors in the execution of bidding instructions. The auctioneer shall regulate the bidding and in the event of any dispute his decision shall be final.
4. Any lot, the description of which is incorrect is returnable, but only within five days of receipt. All disputed lots must be returned intact as received. **The following lots may not be returned for any reason whatsoever: Lots containing ten or more stamps; Lots from buyers who have had the opportunity to examine them before the sale; Lots described as having defects or faults may not be returned because of any faults. No illustrated lots may be returned because of centering, margins or other factors shown in the illustrations.**
5. Successful bidders, unless they are known to us or supply acceptable references are expected to make payment in full before the lots are delivered. Mail bidders will be notified of the amounts of their purchases. All mail bidders who have established credit with us must make payment within three days after receipt. We reserve the right in our sole and absolute discretion to demand cash payment at the time a lot is knocked down to any bidder who has not previously established credit with us or whose account is in arrears. In the event any buyer refuses to pay cash for any lot at the time it is knocked down to him, the auctioneer reserves the right to re-offer the lot immediately for sale to the highest bidder.
6. If the purchase price has not been paid within the time limit, nor lots taken up within seven days from date of sale they must be resold and any loss arising from such sale will be charged to the defaulter. Any account more than thirty days in arrears is subject to a late payment charge of 1½% per month so long as the account remains in arrears. If the auctioneer, in his discretion, should institute any action to secure payment of a delinquent account the defaulting purchaser shall pay all expenses incurred by the auctioneer and such charges will be added to the amount owed.

It is with great pleasure that I present the Sheriff Collection of 19th Century Stamps and Covers. This collection is without a doubt the finest one man assemblage of its type to be offered at public auction in very many years.

Mr. Sheriff built his collection over a period of 14 years with much care and a keen eye for the rare and unusual. As a true philatelist he not only enjoyed and appreciated his stamps but studied and worked diligently at understanding the stamps and postal history which he acquired. He read and mastered the specialized literature pertaining to his areas of collecting and is particularly knowledgeable on the 1c 1851-57 issue.

Mr. Sheriff's fascination with the grill varieties of the 1867, 1869 and Bank Note Issues is evidenced by some of the outstanding items being offered here.

In addition to this collection, Mr. Sheriff has built collections of United States cut squares, carriers and locals, Twentieth Century rarities and most importantly his outstanding collection of Departmental "Specimens" and "Specimen" overprints. The "Specimen" portion of this collection unquestionably contains the largest number of these rare errors ever assembled by one individual.

Mr. Sheriff modestly describes himself as a "general collector of United States 19th (and 20th) Century stamps with interests that vary from time to time." His particular interests are rarities, "not because they are expensive, but because they are rare."

I look forward to "passing title" of these fabulous stamps and covers to their new owners whom I hope will enjoy and treasure them as much as Mr. Sheriff.
