CONDITIONS OF SALE

1. On all lots sold a commission of 10% on the hammer price is payable by the buyer.
2. The terms of sale are strictly cash on delivery to the highest bidder unless special arrangements have been made prior to the sale. The fact that an item is placed on extension (submitted to an expertising committee for certification) does not relieve the successful bidder from this condition of sale.
3. All bids are per lot as numbered in the catalogue unless otherwise announced by the auctioneer at the time of sale. The right is reserved to group two or more lots; to withdraw any lot or lots from the sale, or to act on behalf of the seller. The Galleries will bid on behalf of clients, but will not be responsible for any errors in the execution of bidding instructions. The auctioneer shall regulate the bidding and in the event of any dispute his decision shall be final.
4. Any lot, the description of which is incorrect, is returnable, but only within 14 days of receipt. All disputed lots must be returned intact as received. **The following lots may not be returned for any reason whatsoever: Lots containing ten or more stamps; Lots from buyers who have had the opportunity to examine them before the sale; Lots described as having defects or faults may not be returned because of any faults. No illustrated lots may be returned because of centering, margins or other factors shown in the illustrations.**
5. Successful bidders, unless they are known to us or supply acceptable references are expected to make payment in full before the lots are delivered. Mail bidders will be notified of the amounts of their purchases. All mail bidders who have established credit with us must make payment within three days after receipt. We reserve the right in our sole and absolute discretion to demand cash payment at the time a lot is knocked down to any bidder who has not previously established credit with us or whose account is in arrears. In the event any buyer refuses to pay cash for any lot at the time it is knocked down to him, the auctioneer reserves the right to re-offer the lot immediately for sale to the highest bidder. Sales tax will be added to purchases where applicable.
6. If the purchase price has not been paid within the time limit, nor lots taken up within seven days from date of sale they must be resold and any loss arising from such sale will be charged to the defaulter. Any account more than thirty days in arrears is subject to a late payment charge of 1½% per month so long as the account remains in arrears. If the auctioneer, in his discretion, should institute any action to secure payment of a delinquent account the defaulting purchaser shall pay all expenses incurred by the auctioneer and such charges will be added to the amount owed.
7. All lots are sold as genuine but should any lot be proved otherwise by written opinion of any competent, responsible authority acceptable to us, immediate refund of the full purchase price will be made, provided that such claim is made in writing within 14 days from date of sale. If claim is not made within this period, no lots are returnable for any reason at any time. So long as we are notified within the 14 day period that an opinion is being sought and **the material is submitted to an acceptable authority within that period** the matter will remain open until such opinion is rendered. **We will not be responsible for any charges incurred by the buyer for expertization fees and costs unless the opinion states the item is not genuine, in which case we will pay actual costs up to a maximum of \$50.00.** In the event an item is proved "not as described" it is returnable for full refund, and the buyer will be paid interest (at the prevailing Treasury Bill Rate) for the time his funds have been on deposit with us during the extension period.
8. Until paid for in full, all lots remain the property of Robert A. Siegel Auction Galleries, Inc. on behalf of the seller.

AN OPEN LETTER TO THE APS MEMBERSHIP

Our American Philatelic Research Library is having a problem right now, but on a much larger scale than most of us will ever experience. The APRL has built its reputation as the largest public philatelic library in the United States on the size of its collection: well over 60,000 books and periodicals. Nearly all of these items are accessible to APS/APRL members, as well as to the general public, which can borrow materials from the American Philatelic Research Library through the inter-library loan system.

Well, under present conditions, the APRL's good reputation is beginning to be its undoing. Collectors know that the APRL is a good caretaker, and one that will make any donated materials available to the hobby at large. As a result, donations of books and magazines and catalogues have been coming in at a truly astonishing rate over the past few years!

And so the stacks of boxes grow, with no room to sort and shelve the contents and make them accessible to users. With no formal acquisitions budget, the library *welcomes* literature gifts. But, right now, the APRL's corner of the American Philatelic Building simply cannot absorb the overflow from too many more stamp dens.

The library must expand — or explode! — in the near future. An architect has presented drawings to the APRL Trustees that will provide an additional 3,130 square feet of space for the library, essentially pushing the back wall of the building out twenty-six feet. For a little extra expense, the terrain will allow us to have a basement as well, and this will provide storage for "dead" items, such as duplicate runs of older periodicals. Considering the cost of such construction, we are glad to be in central Pennsylvania and not in a major urban area — although in a city, we probably would lack the land to expand anyway.

None of us here could do our jobs well or easily without the APRL, and the larger its collection, the more useful it is to all of us. We want to unpack those stacks of boxes and get the contents into circulation. We want to move Ernie Kehr's clipping files out of that warehouse and see what treasures of information they hold. We want to be able to continue to accept the philatelic literature that our members no longer have room to store!

It's time for the library to have the equivalent of that new album, that bigger box, that larger stamp room. A few dollars from each of our 56,000 members would go a long way toward making the addition to the APRL debt-free, but we also are sincerely hoping for extra support from those APS members who have shown the most respect for philatelic information.

Of course, all donations to the American Philatelic Research Library are tax deductible.
