The Silver Lake Collection

Quality in Philately Means different things to different people. A professional philatelist must listen to many collectors and learn to understand the diverse perspectives that exist in the marketplace. Two collectors can look at the same stamp and form opposing opinions. One sees big margins and perfect centering and falls in love. The other sees a worn impression and cancel over the portrait and turns the page. While there is some truth in the concept that philatelic beauty is in the eye of the beholder, there must also be a standard. Today, when we hear about numerical grading of stamps, the basic issue is *consistency*. Markets demand consistent standards, because traders can handle rising and falling prices, but they cannot deal with substantive changes in product.

Thinking out loud about grading standards is my way of introducing the Silver Lake collection, because this stamp collection is not about completeness. It is all about quality. The stamps in this collection are unusually beautiful. They are for the most part in condition collectors decribe as "Mint" and "Post-Office Fresh". The plate blocks appear to have been selected today from sheets at the post office. Viewed in the album, the Silver Lake collection is a dazzling array of this country's stamps. Take each stamp out and turn it over, and the pristine quality of the gum erases any notion that the stamp was issued long ago.

When we talk of standards, the concern is not only protecting collectors (or *consumers*) from sub-standard stamps offered as something better than they are. It is equally important to educate collectors about the premium value of stamps that are superior to the general supply. The *Scott Catalogue* editors recognized this responsibility when they standardized (and annotated) the grades upon which stamps are valued, as well as adding Never Hinged values to many listings. In our sale catalogues, we have expanded our descriptions to include judgements about condition relative to the existing population of any given issue. We trust that our developing database of stamps will eliminate some of the subjectivity and guesswork in making such judgements.

The Silver Lake collection is remarkable in many specific instances. Here are a few of the stamps that we have rarely encountered:

The obvious redundant use of the term Mint Never-Hinged is deliberate. Anyone who spends time waiting for certain stamps to be offered in this pristine state will appreciate the achievement of the collector behind the Silver Lake collection and the opportunity presented by this auction.



VERY FINE AND CHOICE. AN INCREDIBLY RARE MINT NEVER-HINGED EXAMPLE OF THE 1857 3-CENT PERFORATED TYPE I STAMP.

Unlike its Type II counterpart, the 3c Type I, which was produced in 1857 by perforating sheets from the earlier imperforate issue, is virtually impossible to find in Mint N.H. condition. Our search of previous auction catalogues confirms this observation. In addition, because the Type I plate did not provide sufficient space for perforations, stamps with complete lines on three sides are very scarce. Thus, a 3c Type I stamp in Mint Never-Hinged condition with complete lines on three sides is a great rarity, of which only a sparse few exist.

EXTREMELY FINE. A REMARKABLY CHOICE MINT NEVERHINGED EXAMPLE OF THE $1860\,$ 5-CENT BROWN TYPE II WITH ORIGINAL GUM.

Unlike its Orange Brown counterpart, the 5c Type II in Brown was not on hand in post offices when the 1861 demonetization order took effect. Therefore, original-gum examples of Scott 30A (the Brown shade) are far rarer than Scott 30, and the few Mint N.H. examples extant were probably harvested from blocks, in which one or two stamps escaped hinging. The narrow spacing between subjects on the plate and Toppan Carpenter's imprecise perforating leave collectors with few sound, well-centered Mint Never-Hinged examples.

Although some sheets of the 24c, 30c and 90c 1857-60 Issue remained in Southern post offices after their demonetization during the Civil War, Mint Never-Hinged examples of the 30c are extremely rare, particularly in any higher grade.



EXTREMELY FINE. A BEAUTIFUL ORIGINAL-GUM EXAMPLE OF THE 10-CENT 1861 WITH DOUBLE TRANSFER IN "TAG" OF "POSTAGE". AN EXTREMELY SCARCE STAMP IN THIS QUALITY.

The increased awareness of the rarity of 1847 to 1879 issues in superb original-gum condition has elevated many valuations for issues with modest Scott values. The 1861-66 issues are prime examples of this trend. This 10c 1861 has a Scott value of \$925. yet one would be challenged to locate more than a few examples with original gum, choice centering and rich color, the characteristics that make this stamp so extraordinary.

Knowledgeable collectors recognize and appreciate the great rarity of well-centered, original gum classics. In particular, the 1861-66 Issue has been "discovered" as one of the most challenging of all. As recent auction realizations show, collectors ignore Scott values in pursuing these elusive examples.

39★ 24c Brown Lilac (70a). Original gum, lightly hinged, choice centering, deep dark shade and detailed impression

EXTREMELY FINE. A STUNNING ORIGINAL-GUM COPY OF THE 1861 24-CENT BROWN LILAC IN A REMARKABLE STATE OF FRESHNESS.

This stamp ranks highly among the finest original-gum examples of the 24c Brownish Lilac we have ever encountered. The color is a deep brownish shade, which is quite distinctive and much different than the Red Lilac (1862) or later Lilac (1863-66) printings.

The Steel Blue shade was produced early in the series of 24c 1861 shades, and it is scarce in any condition. Examples with original gum are rare, and those with Very Fine or Extremely Fine centering are of tremendous rarity, probably numbering no more than ten.

41 ** 90c Blue (72). Original gum in Mint N.H. state, brilliant color and crisp impression on bright paper with long full perfs all around

VERY FINE. AN EXTRAORDINARILY RARE MINT NEVERHINGED EXAMPLE OF THE 90-CENT 1861 ISSUE.

Like the other high value 1861 issues, the 90c is usually available in unused no-gum condition or low grades of original-gum condition. Fresh Mint Never-Hinged examples are great rarities.

The 5c 1861-68 Issue was printed from plates with closely-spaced subjects that left little room for the large 12-gauge perforations. The Brown shade, No. 76, is scarce in original-gum condition and truly rare in this high grade.

EXTREMELY FINE. AN UNBELIEVABLY RARE MINT NEVER-HINGED EXAMPLE OF THE 15-CENT 1861-66 ISSUE IN THE FINEST CONDITION ATTAINABLE. WITH THE EXCEPTION OF SOME SHADE VARIETIES, THE 15-CENT LINCOLN IS PERHAPS THE RAREST OF THE 1861-66 SERIES STAMPS IN SUCH CHOICE ORIGINAL-GUM CONDITION.

Throughout recent Siegel sales that have contained a remarkable group of original-gum 1861-66 Issues, we have made frequent reference to the rarity of these stamps in choice condition. With the exception of the rare 5c and 24c shades, our experience shows that the 15c Lincoln is the most difficult stamp to obtain in sound, choice original-gum condition. It is most often found without gum or with disturbed gum. Examples with full original gum are frequently off-center. The block of six (straight edge at left), ex Caspary, Lilly and Ishikawa, is well-centered with original gum, but our search of numerous other major auction sales produced few other examples apart from the block. Therefore, this stamp could be the rarest *face-different* design of the 1861-66 series in choice original-gum condition. As a Mint Never-Hinged stamp, it should be considered an even greater rarity.

1867-68 GRILLED ISSUE

45 ★ 1c Blue, E. Grill (86). Original gum, lightly hinged, bright blue color and proof-like impression on fresh paper, clear grill points

> EXTREMELY FINE. THE 1868 ONE-CENT E GRILL IS FAR SCARCER THAN ITS F-GRILL COUNTERPART, PARTICULARLY IN ORIGINAL GUM CONDITION.

> Some time ago we observed that the 1c E Grill appeared at auction very infrequently, in any form. After analyzing the early 1868 regular-production grills (Z, D, E and F), we concluded that grilling of the 1c 1861 issue with the E (and Z) Grill must have been short-lived, occurring sometime around February 28, 1868. Later grilling of 1c stamps was probably done with the F Grill. Relatively little of the 1c E Grill supply appears to have reached the philatelic market, as evidenced by the stamp's scarcity.

> The first sheets of 3c stamps run through the different grilling devices in 1867 and 1868 have a distinctive Rose shade. At first glance, this stamp looks like its C or D Grill counterparts. 

The 90c 1869 Pictorial is widely admired for its beautiful engraving and dignified portrait of Abraham Lincoln. Used 90c stamps are typically heavily cancelled, because the high denomination was cause for postal clerks to thoroughly obliterate any chance for re-use. Naturally, the significant monetary value of 90c in 1869 limited the number of unused stamps that would be saved for future collectors. Therefore, the collector ideals of "well-centered with original gum" and "lightly cancelled" are seldom obtainable in the available supply of 90c 1869's. The stamp offered here, with lightly-hinged original gum and choice centering, probably ranks among the top 3% of surviving 90c 1869's in unused state.

As beautiful as this 90c 1869 Re-issue is on the face, it is the back that is most remarkable. The gum is pristine, with a totally undisturbed pattern of crackles, which are characteristic of 1869 Re-issue original gum. Gum on high-value Re-issues is almost always hinged, for the simple reason that the stamps were sold by the Post Office Department to philatelists, who usually hinged them in 19th Century stamp albums, long before anyone imagined that the gum would one day be a significant aspect of condition. Very few blocks of the high-denomination Re-issues have ever been available, which limits the supply of Mint N.H. stamps out of broken blocks. In the case of the 90c 1869 Re-issue, the famous plate block is the only recorded block, and its existence suggests that other stamps may have been attached at one time and removed. Therefore, this stamp and the plate block may have the same provenance.







The 30c 1879 American Bank Note Company issue is surprisingly difficult to obtain in choice Mint N.H. condition. It is surprising because the 15c (Scott 189) is readily available. However, a survey of our photo records and auction library revealed the scarcity of well-centered 30c blocks from which singles could be harvested. The blocks in the Green sales were off center. Caspary had a well-centered hinged block of four, and Lilly had a block of nine with problems. The Moody block of six was well-centered, but appears to have had hinge remnants on all stamps. The Todd collection had two blocks, including one with a Mint N.H. pair at bottom (this has probably been broken, furnishing at least two Mint N.H. stamps). The Close collection had a well-centered block of four (with reinforcing) and a large plate block. The Siegel firm's three major Bank Note Issue sales (Braus, Hirschfield, Wunderlich) contained blocks, but all were either off center or had hinge remnants. A well-centered block of four appeared in our 1982 Rarities sale, but it was hinged.

The Type Ia Scott 500 was created during an experiment of the Bureau in creating a new type of transfer roll. A die was made from the old Type I transfer roll, having ten impressions on it. A new transfer roll was then made, using the new ten-impression master die. This new transfer roll was then used to create two new plates. Since this is essentially a "lossy" process, there are some noticeable differences between the plates created using this method and the old method of using one die impression to create the transfer roll.


