

The Vineyard Collection

COLLECTORS ARE OFTEN DESCRIBED AS HAVING AN EYE FOR QUALITY, but rarely does one hear about a "mind" for quality. In this writer's opinion, the mind plays a far more important role in collecting. Knowing what exists and how one object compares to the rest is the key to discriminating taste.

This observation was inspired by the Vineyard Collection, which we are pleased to present in this sale catalogue. The formation of a collection of such choice quality and great breadth requires knowledge, dedicated effort and a substantial degree of patience. Its highlights present an opportunity to appreciate the mind of a collector who possesses a carefully-developed standard of quality.

Among the rare Postmasters' Provisionals are superb examples of the famous St. Louis "Bears", including a 10c on Greenish Paper cancelled solely by the red town datestamp (lot 3004)—examples without the usual pen cancel are very rare and desirable—and the 5c on Gray Lilac paper (lot 3005). The 5c Gray Lilac, Scott 11X4, was printed from the second state of the plate, which contained three 10c positions, but only one 5c position (Position 5). Only a few sound examples of the 5c Gray Lilac exist, and the stamp offered here is one of the finest.

A beautiful array of imperforate classics is highlighted by two extraordinary examples of the 1c 1851 Type Ib (lots 3011 and 3012), including one from Position 6R1E (one of two on the plate that furnished the best examples of the type).

The collection boasts a plethora of superb Bank Note issues, highlighted by a beautiful original-gum 10c 1870 National Grilled Issue (lot 3129), one of the finest we have ever offered. Several of the rare Bank Note Special Printings are featured, including one of the finest recorded copies of Scott 205C (lot 3180).

20th Century issues are represented by choice singles, coil multiples and major rarities such as the 4c and 8c Bluish Paper (lots 3302 and 3305), and an Extremely Fine Scott 476A (lot 3390). A small but select group of plate blocks and complete booklets provides the segue into Back-of-the-Book issues. Rarely has the Siegel firm been able to offer so many superb examples of the Postage Due, Official and Newspapers & Periodicals stamps, featuring several major rarities and a large number of Mint Never-Hinged examples, which are rare by virtue of their condition.

The Vineyard Collection will take its proper place among significant name sales held by the Siegel firm during the past 70 years. Despite his desire to remain anonymous, the collector behind the collection deserves the greatest accolades.

Most used "Bears" are either cancelled by penstroke or a combination of penstrokes and the red datestamp. This sound 10c cancelled solely by a red datestamp is extremely rare.



St. Louis Mo., 5c Black on Gray Lilac (11X4). Type III (Position 5), large to huge margins, unusually deep impression, cancelled by two unobtrusive penstrokes

The St. Louis Bear stamps were printed from a single plate of six subjects (two horizontal by three vertical) that was modified twice to change the denominations of two positions. The original plate (First State) contained three 5c stamps at left and three 10c stamps at right. All stamps from the First State plate were printed on Greenish paper. The plate was then altered by burnishing out the "5" on Positions 1 and 3 and engraving a new "20" denomination (Second State). A small printing on Greenish paper was made from this Second State altered plate. 5c stamps (Position 5) and 10c stamps (Positions 2/4/6) on Greenish Paper cannot usually be identified as First State or Second State impressions (the 20c on Greenish paper is a great rarity). The larger portion of stamps from the Second State plate are on Gray Lilac paper. However, because only one of six subjects was a 5c value, the 5c on Gray Lilac is an extremely rare stamp — perhaps even rarer than the 20c on Gray Lilac. The plate was modified again by burnishing out the "20" and engraving the old "5" denomination (Third State). At the time of this second alteration, a large ball was engraved inside the end curl of the numeral "5" on Position 5. As far as we know, all stamps from the Third Plate were printed on a very thin pelure paper. These were the last stamps used before the 1847 Issue was placed on sale in St. Louis.

Six positions on Plate 1 Early furnished stamps qualifying as Type Ib — Positions 3-6R and 8-9R — distinguished by the complete design at top and nearly complete design at bottom. When first entered on the plate, these six positions (as well as 7R1E) had the complete design at top and bottom. However, unlike 7R, small portions of the bottoms were burnished away. Positions 6R and 8R had less of the bottom erased than the other Type Ib positions, and for this reason they are more desirable examples of the type.


All Type Ib stamps are very scarce, and the two best examples (6R and 9R) are rare. These top-row positions usually have an ample top margin, but frequently the margins are close or cutting into the sides or bottom. The example offered is a condition rarity.

Type Ia was furnished by only eighteen of the 1,000 plate positions that produced imperforate 1c 1851 stamps. Stamps printed from Plate 4 were issued in April, May and briefly in June 1857 before perforations were introduced. The relatively small number of imperforate Plate 4 stamps issued during this period explains the rarity and desirability of any of the imperforate stamp types produced from this plate (Ia, Ic, II, III and IIIa). The extremely rare Type Ia, showing the full design at bottom, was furnished only by 18 of the 200 subjects on Plate 4 (the remaining two bottom-row positions were sub-type Ic).

As has been documented by Jerome S. Wagshal in a series of *Chronicle* articles (Nos. 56, 60, 61 and 62), Carl F. Rothfuchs, a Washington D.C. stamp dealer, obtained a supply of the 3c Scarlet in 1893 — probably from the Post Office Department in exchange for his assistance with the Columbian Exposition — and sold them with pen marks and original gum. The Rothfuchs lot is not from the same supply acquired by John W. Scott in the late 1870's, from which stamps exist uncancelled and cancelled with a New York City Station D oval.

According to Johl (Vol. 1, p. 111), the Bureau quickly switched to Perf 8½ for their coils after a very short period of time because the Perf 12 coils fell apart in the machines used to affix (and make) the coils. Scott 386 was one of the first to be discontinued.



In an article in *Philatelic Opinions V* published by the Philatelic Foundation, William T. Crowe, head of the Expert Committee, discusses the discovery of this rare stamp and how it might have been issued. The production of Scott 476A occurred during the period of transition from gauge-10 perfs to gauge 11. Bureau records do not list a 30c printing on unwatermarked paper that was perforated 10, but the existence of two certified panes—one bottom-right pane from Plate 6917 and one top-right pane from Plate 6911—is evidence that the combination of new unwatermarked paper and old 10-gauge perfs occurred, even if inadvertantly. Stamps from these two panes (200 total), two left sheetmargin blocks of four and a bottom plate no. 6914 single, none of which have any trace of watermark, are the only accepted examples of Scott 476A.

The A.E.F. booklet panes were issued in September 1917, primarily for use by the American Expeditionary Forces in Europe during World War I. By October they were no longer needed for the post card rate, as Congress passed a vote allowing first-class mail to be sent free of charge by active members of the Armed Forces. Many of the panes were destroyed.
