

The Office in China double surcharge error occurred during the overprinting of stamps for use at the U.S. Postal Agency in Shanghai. It has been reported that the errors were among the last stamps to be put on sale before the agency closed on December 31, 1922. The Deputy Postal Agent, Mr. E. H. Murray, knew of the error but allowed it to be put on sale, as he was retiring and the Agency was closing. This stamp is far scarcer in used condition. Approximately six covers are known.

SPECIAL PRINTINGS

According to J. Murray Bartels, the U.S. dealer who handled many of the U.S. Possessions Special Printings after they were released, the story begins with the Exposition Universelle held in Paris, France, from April 15 through November 12, 1900. As part of the celebration of the new century, the U.S. Post Office Department exhibited all of the postage stamps overprinted for use at post offices on the island possessions of Cuba, Guam, Philippines and Puerto Rico, the newly-acquired spoils of the Spanish-American War. Although supplies of the regularly-overprinted stamps were unavailable, the Bureau provided one ordinary sheet of each value that was then overprinted with the original electrotype plates. H. G. Mandel, who was associated with the American Bank Note Co. and was appointed to arrange the U.S. stamp exhibit, decided to show a single and block of each value. Upon delivery from the Bureau, two sets of singles and blocks were mounted in separate frames for display at the Paris Exposition and the 1901 Pan-American Exposition in Buffalo, New York. Most of the few copies saved from each sheet were stamped "Special Surcharge" in red on the back. As compensation for his services, Mandel was

permitted to retain additional copies from the same sheets. Some he stamped in black, similar to those in the exhibit, and others were stamped in red. Thus, while a few Special Printings also exist with

"Specimen" handstamps, not all of the "Specimens" are Special Printings.

FINE APPEARANCE. A RARE COMBINATION IMPRINT AND PLATE NUMBER STRIP OF THREE COMBINING TYPE I AND II. A GREAT RARITY OF THE ISSUE, WHICH DOES NOT EXIST AS A FULL PLATE BLOCK.

The \$1.00 1894-95 plate — comprising 200 subjects arranged in two panes of 100 — included five vertical columns of Type II (50 subjects). The left half of one pane was made up of Type I stamps, and the right half of the same pane comprised Type II stamps. The other pane was entirely Type I. Therefore, where the imprint and plate number appears at top and bottom, the two stamps at right are Type II, and the one stamp at left is Type I. Combination pairs and strips, which exist only between fifth and sixth columns, are extremely rare and desirable. Plate number strips and blocks are of even greater rarity. When one factors in the Philippines overprint, the rarity increases exponentially.
