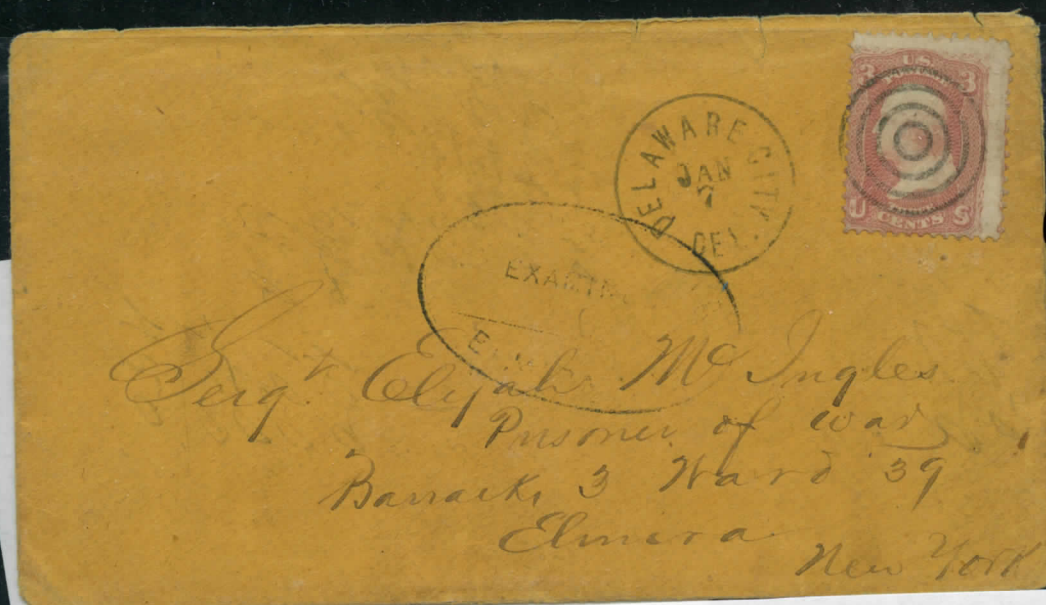

Morfit, Box 263, Baltimore, Md. with mandated docketing "Lieut. H. J. Cartwright, Co. F., 9th Ala. Vols. C.S.A., Prisoner of War, Div. 23, Fort Delaware, Dec. 19th, 1864." Examiners' markings were discontinued there in November 1864. Extremely Fine. Docketed as letter #19 in their correspondence. \$350.



16913 FORT DELAWARE, Delaware. US #65, 3c rose (couple tiny perf faults) used with grid and matching Delaware City, Del, June 22 [1864] cds on cover to Bessie Johnston, 70 Monument St, Baltimore, Md. The oval prisoner examined marking was only used for 7 months from 12 April to 29 October, 1864, per Harrison; couple edge tears. \$150.

envelope filled with penciled list of items which appear to be an expense record for purchases at the prison. Ex

RICHMOND, says to send word if he knows anything about her, he enquires about numerous girls by name, & more, very neatly written Confederate prisoner of war letter. Capt. Heiskell who is mentioned is Felix D. Heiskell, who was a lieutenant in the Hampshire Guards which at the outbreak of the war reported to T.J. Jackson at Harpers Ferry. They then were mustered into the 13th Va. Inf. under A.P. Hill. The town of Hampshire, Va. is mentioned in Lovett's letter. Capt. J. Mortimer Lovett commanded Co. E, 23rd Virginia Cavalry!.
