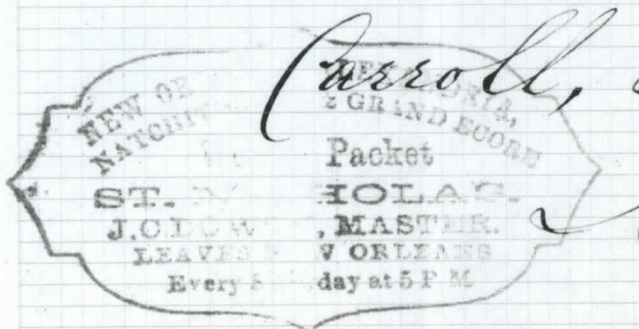


Illustration 3: Closeup of Agent's Mark

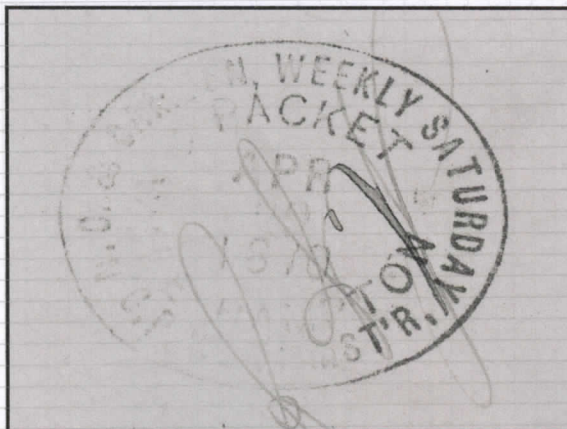


Illustration 1: Closeup of Agent's Mark

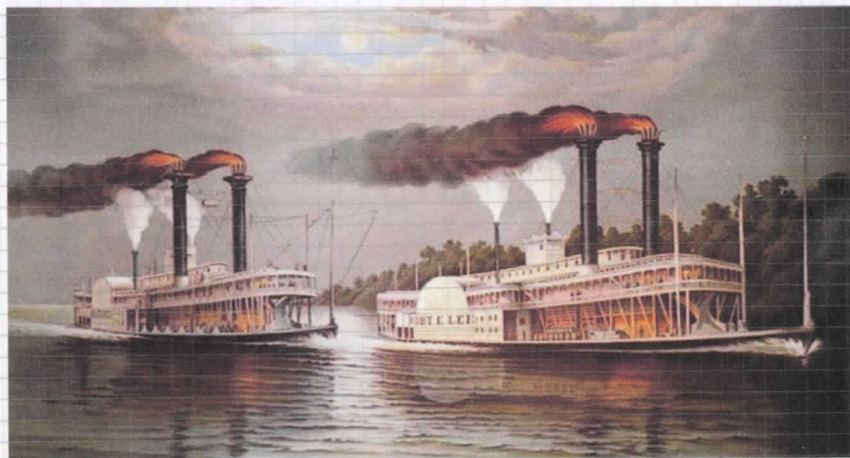

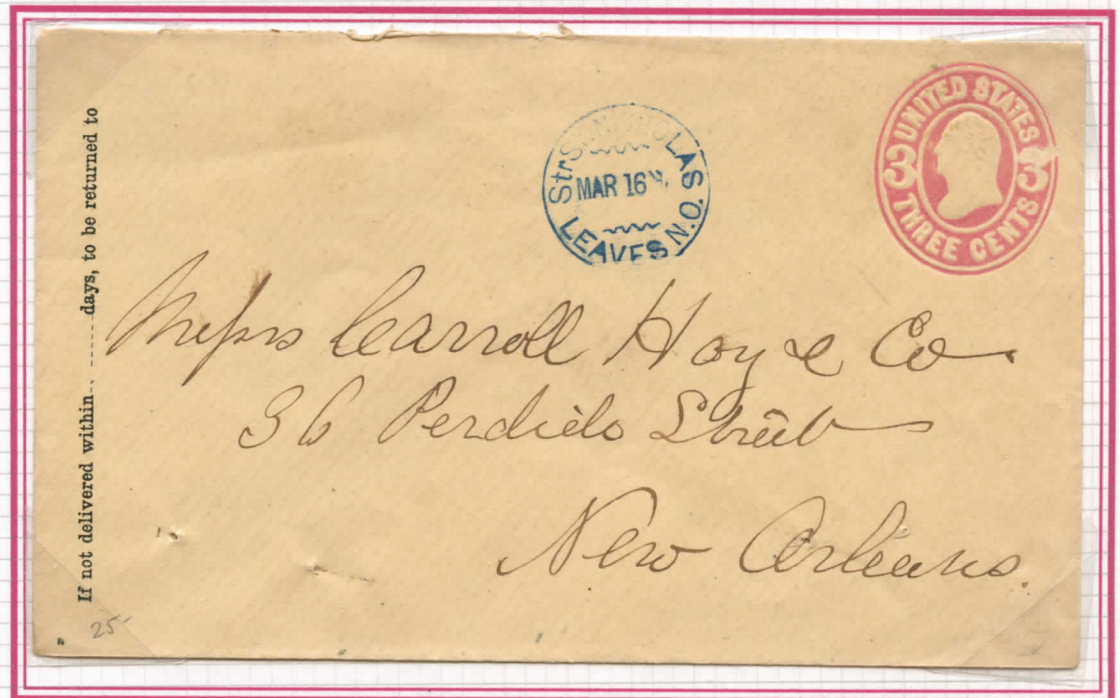

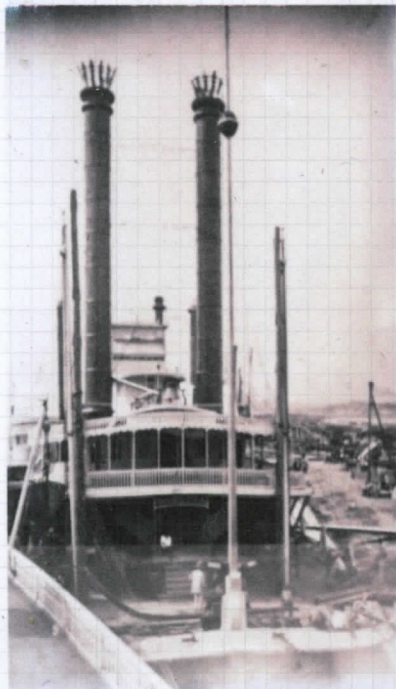

organization unknown.

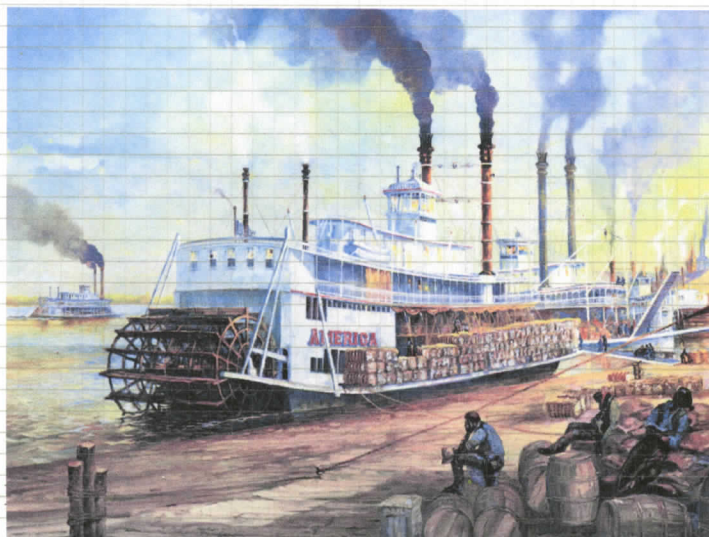
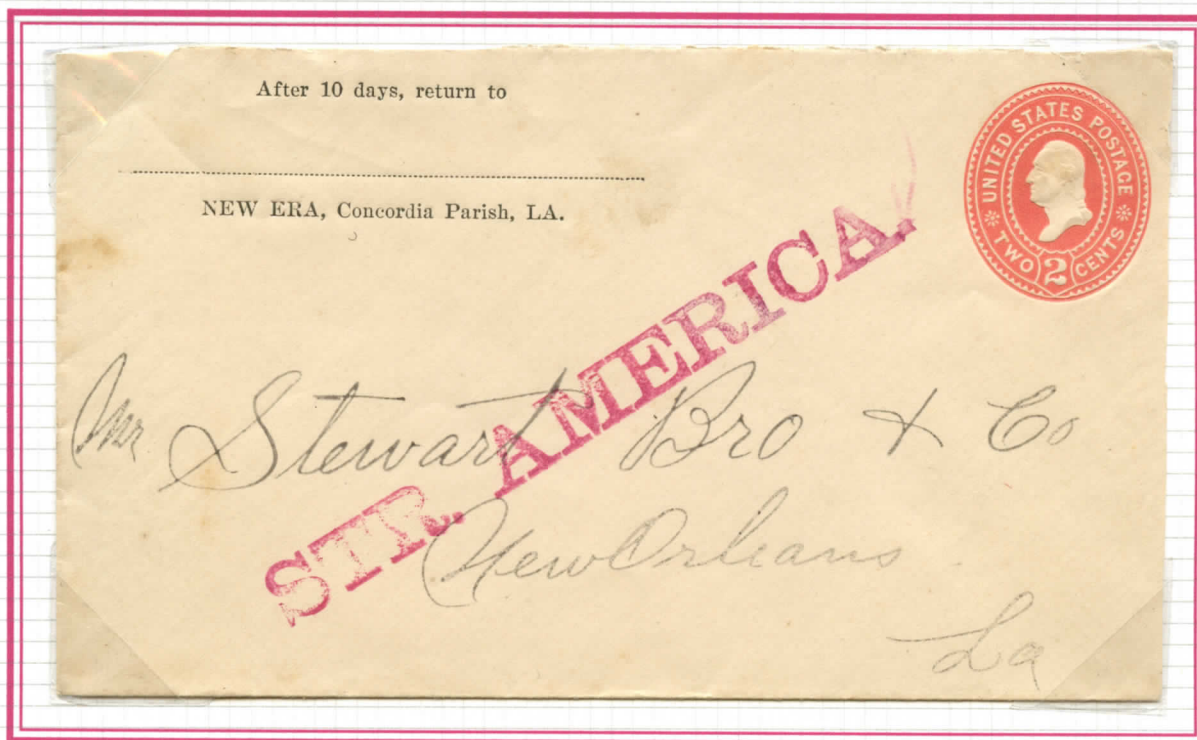
Carried on the Magenta to New Orleans from either  
Natchez or Vicksburg then entered the US mail  
system in New Orleans postmarked and carried  
overland to West Virginia.

**Ouachita River Mail Packet**  
**Steamer AMERICA**  
**Circa 1899 New Era, La. To New Orleans**

Constructed 1898 and designed for the Ouachita River trade. 200'x38' with 6.5 ft draft, built specifically for Captain L.V. Cooley

Competition between railroads and steamboats grew in the early 1900's. In 1905 Captain L.V. Cooley steamed his boat, the "America" to Camden, Arkansas to pick up 500 bales of cotton for delivery to New Orleans. Upon arrival, Cooley found the railroads also bidding for the same delivery ended in a war with Cooley finally winning. Cooley delivered the cotton to New Orleans for only one dollar.
